Conditions for Construction

- □ Maintain all traffic signs in current location. Any temporary relocation to be done by the Township of Esquimalt at the Developer's or Contractor's expense.
- □ All works including trench excavation and backfill to comply with MMCD standards.
- □ Applicant to arrange for the necessary blasting permits through the Township of Esquimalt.
- □ All emergency services (Fire, Police, Ambulance) to be notified prior to construction.
- □ Municipal inspection personnel shall be notified 24 hours in advance of any construction.
- Advise residents 24 hours in advance of any anticipated disruptions to services and/or access to property.
- □ Traffic control plan, in accordance with Work Safe BC requirements shall be provided along with the following:

Standard traffic control signs and barricades to be provided by the contractor, as required.
Qualified traffic control to be present at all times during construction.

- □ Utilities (gas, hydro, telephone, cable, City of Victoria mains) to be given due notice prior to ensure no conflict to their respective services.
- □ Temporary asphalt patching required.
- □ Lane closures will be allowed between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Single lane alternating traffic must be maintained during lane closures. All lanes must remain open during all other times unless prior written authorization from the Director of Engineering and Public Works is received.
- □ Open excavations and material/equipment stockpile to be securely barricaded and marked with flashing lights during non-working hours.
- Damage to Township of Esquimalt's services to be reported immediately. All repairs to be performed by the Township of Esquimalt personnel.
- □ All public and private roads, drives, boulevards, fences, etc., to be restored to "as found", or better, condition.
- □ Adjacent roads and sidewalks to be kept clean during construction. Costs borne by the Municipality will be billed to the applicant.
- Where subgrade is modified or exposed, provide test reports showing compaction to a density not less than 95% Modified Proctor Density
- All road surface restoration to be completed by Township of Esquimalt forces. Please contact the Public Works Manager for coordination of works. Applicant will be billed for associated restoration costs upon completion of works.

Permission has been granted for construction of the proposed works within the limit of a highway at the above-referenced location in accordance with Municipal By-laws, Construction Specifications and the above conditions.

A Road Allowance Construction Permit is required for permission to construct any works within the Municipal road allowance or any Municipal Right-of-Way. **Applications must be made a minimum of 48 hours prior to the commencement of works.**
